As of June 1, 2000, UDcast has been incorporated in France, by four members of INRIA research center (Clerget, Cipièrre, Duros and Ottavj) and one from the computing industry (D. Tymen), the headquarter of the company is located in Sophia Antipolis on the french riviera.

UDcast delivers off the shelf software and hardware products and services based on the UDLR technology that enable the interconnection of IP networks through Unidirectional Links. UDcast invests in its standardisation and plays a great part in the improvement of the UDLR protocol by participating at IETF, the international organization in charge of specifying Internet protocols. We deliver complete solutions for transmission and reception, as well as services for deployment, administration and maintenance. Our solutions are optimized and scale to a large number of receivers.

Unidirectional links like digital satellite links, digital hertzian TV links and digital radio links are perfects to address some of the key challenges of the Internet, like rapid expansion, high speed access, delivery/access anywhere or anyplace.

UDcast mission is to develop off the shelf software which runs on standards hardware but also services to allow to use Internet in a full transparent way on those medias.

UDcast develop the UDLR standard, and Multicast scalable internet infrastructure software to integrate totally and tranparently the Internet on top of Unidirectional links.
